## **MINUTES**

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE / INVOCATION:

Police Chief Kevin Yates led the Pledge of Allegiance. Adrian Dale, Town of Wise Street Superintendent, provided the invocation.

**AGENDA CHANGES:** 

Town Manager Laura Roberts advised that there were no changes to the agenda.

**CONSENT CALENDAR:** 

Caynor Smith, Jr. made a motion to approve the consent calendar, which included the minutes of the August 21, 2024 special-called Council meeting, minutes of the August 27, 2024 joint Council meeting with Planning Commission, minutes of the September 3, 2024 continued Council meeting, the June 2024 Treasurer's Financial Report, the August 2024 Police and Water Plant Reports, and the September 2024 Fire Department and Recreation Specialist Reports. Jeffery Dotson seconded the motion that passed 5-0.

#### **PUBLIC EXPRESSION:**

There being no one from the public audience wishing to comment, Mayor Adkins closed public expression.

## **DISCUSSION OF DEPARTMENT HEAD REQUESTS:**

Town Manager Laura Roberts advised that Special Events Coordinator Natasha Proulex had Centennial Committee and Council banners made for use in the upcoming Central High School Homecoming Parade should members decide to participate in the event. Roberts advised Proulex would be in touch to gauge interest in participation.

## PUBLIC HEARING – RESOLUTION #24, 2024:

Town Manager Laura Roberts provided a brief overview of a Conditional Use Permit Application submitted to allow use of an existing structure as a short-term rental unit. A public hearing was held on "A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WISE, VIRGINIA APPROVING A CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT APPLICATION SUBMITTED BY WILLIAM AND JAN THOMPSON FOR USE OF AN EXISTING STRUCTURE LOCATED AT 334 MASONIC STREET AS A SHORT-TERM RENTAL IN AN R-B MEDIUM DENSITY RESIDENCE ZONING DISTRICT". ## **RESOLUTION #25, 2024:**

Town Manager Laura Roberts advised both the Administrative and Treasurer Departments were utilizing the services of Unbound Digital, Inc. for needed Information Technology (IT) services. She noted that by contracting with the provider for all departments, the Town could streamline and consolidate its IT support. Following a brief discussion, councilman Jeffery Dotson moved to adopt "A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WISE, VIRGINIA AUTHORIZING A THREE-YEAR CONTRACT WITH UNBOUND DIGITAL, INC. TO PROVIDE INTERNET SUPPORT SERVICE AND SECURITY FOR THE TOWN OF WISE POLICE DEPARTMENT, TOWN OF WISE FIRE DEPARTMENT, TOWN OF WISE WATER TREATMENT PLANT, AND TOWN OF WISE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT". ## **RESOLUTION #26, 2024:**

Town Clerk/Treasurer Sarina Collins informed that IBM announced hardware maintenance would be withdrawn on the AS400 server used in the Data Processing and Treasurer Departments. She added that a computer system, with the same specifications required by the Town, was available for purchase under a state contract established by the University of Virginia and open for use by public bodies of the Commonwealth. Collins further advised funding for the upgraded computer equipment had been appropriated in the current fiscal year budget.
