Discussion of Re-Opening Veldon Dotson Park:

Mayor Adkins stated that with the reopening of public schools and some parks, she felt it would be prudent for Council to discuss the reopening of Dotson Park. Town Attorney Leonard Rogers reminded the members of Council that the Town was governed by the Governor of Virginia, not the Virginia High School League as school sports were. Town Manager Owens provided the guidelines of Virginia's reopening plan Phase Three. Following a lengthy discussion, Mayor Adkins announced that after listening to the comments, it was apparent that although Council was eager to get all the parks reopened, with the guidelines currently in place in the state of Virginia, it was the consensus for Dotson Park to remain closed.

Council Comment:

Jeff Dotson thanked all the Town's staff who have worked through the coronavirus pandemic.

Laura Taylor-Baugh requested that each member of Council be provided a copy of the Town's VOSHA policy that Council authorized to be developed in July.

When asked for a status update on revisions to the Town's weed cutting resolution, Beverly Owens informed that Lieutenant Chris Kent was working on a revised resolution.

Staff/Manager Comment:

Leonard Rogers provided a status report on the FEMA Hazardous Mitigation Project.
